

Understanding Cause and Effect

Level One Behaviors

- Behavior that *disrupts* teaching and learning
- Failure to follow teacher directions
- Talking out, noisy, or rude
- Off-task behavior
- Creating distractions (such as throwing paper, falling out of chair)
- Failure to respect dress code
- Inappropriate behavior (including hallways and theater)
- Possession of candy, gum, energy drinks, or soda
- Selling items for personal profit
- Other minor disruptions

Level One Consequences

- PRP
- Phone call home
- Parent conference
- Loss of classroom privileges

Level One Notes

Three PRPs in the same class during one semester will result in one After School Detention. PE & Science meets less frequently and therefore requires 2 PRPs for the same time period.

Level Two Behaviors

- Behavior that *stops* teaching and learning
- Choices that jeopardize the safety of any student or staff member (such as running in hallways or courtyard, throwing sharp or heavy objects, etc.)
- Lack of positive problem solving resulting in confrontation
- Electronic devices not assigned by the teacher for use with a specific assignment
- Play fighting or rough housing
- Teasing, harassing, or verbally abusing another
- Cheating / plagiarism
- Three unexcused tardies to the same period during the same semester
- Truant for one period
- Unexcused tardy greater than 15 minutes
- Use of social networking/communication applications such as Facebook, YouTube, MySpace, etc. during school hours or with equipment provided by the District unless directed by a teacher
- Playing inappropriate computer games on campus or in the classroom
- Use of cell phones, camera phones, ipods, and other personal electronic devices on campus during the instructional day
- Other minor disruptions

Level Two Consequences

- After School Detention
- Phone call home and/or parent conference
- Loss of classroom privileges

Level Two Notes

- Three After School Detentions during the same semester will result in one Friday School Detention
- Tardy to an After School Detention will result in one additional After School Detention No-Show to an After School Detention will result in two additional After School Detention assignments

Level Three Behaviors

- Assault/battery/mutual combat or attempt to cause or causes physical injury
- Possession of weapons, explosives, dangerous objects, imitation firearms
- Possession of controlled/prohibited substances, alcohol, or tobacco, or paraphernalia
- Property damage (vandalism or graffiti)
- Property theft
- Obscenities or racial slurs
- Disruption/defiance
- Sexual harassment
- Hate incidents
- Threats or intimidation
- Harassment or hazing
- Leaving school grounds without permission
- Identity theft (stealing passwords and/or accessing another student's account)
- Participation in digital harassment, cyber-bullying, inappropriate or negative comments, or threats that result in a substantial disruption on campus, regardless of where the content was created
- Using digital tools provided by the District to distribute libelous or offensive material
- Not following the rules and guidelines defined by the SDUSD Network Usage Policy

Level Three Consequences

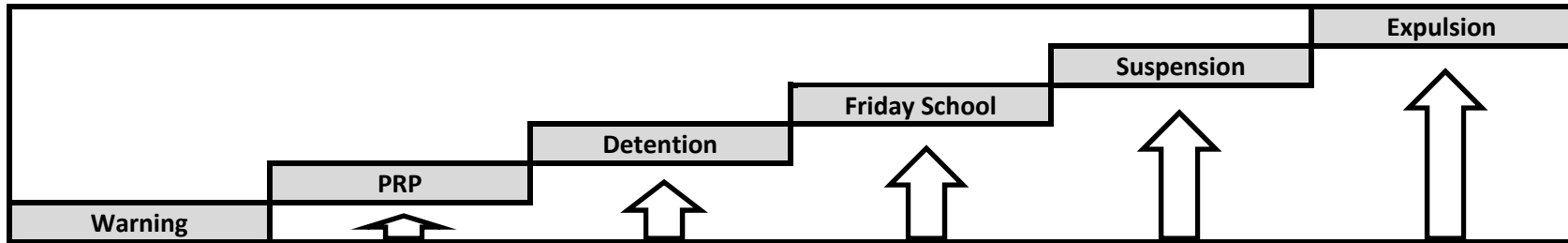
- Friday School Detention

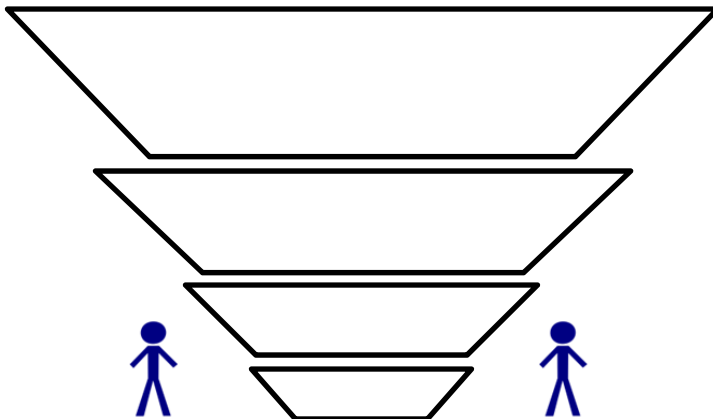
